Who may operate a Brainline Learning Academy?

- A person who has previous **experience** in education, whether it is as a teacher or as a home schooling parent.
- This person is fully trained in the procedures of the Brainline Study material and the assessment website: www.brainonline.com. Training is supplied by Brainline.

Legalities

- A contract for the maintenance and security of the hardware with a third party, may be required.
- A contract for the hours of accessibility to clients may be required.
- A contract, stipulating the relationship with parents.learners, is required.
- A code of conduct for the owner and staff of the centre is required.
- The owner of the centre must have qualifications in education, or may be a Brainline registered user.
- Health and Safety standards are to be maintained.
- Insurance policies has to be in place.
- Suitable security measures are to be maintained.
- The service centre may act as a full time school to learners, who's parents.gaurdian has approved of the Academy and its services. The responsibility of education, remains in the hands of the parents.
- Membership of the Pestalozzi Trust (with resultant fees) is compulsory.
- Quarterly meetings on the Brainline Main Campus, is compulsory.

Where are the Brainline Learning Academies?

- Any site found to be suitable, by Brainline Learning World. The site has to be a suitable venue for the offering of these services, with regard to neatness, health and safety and security.
- The centre has to offer facilities in line with the services offered—hardware and software included.

Appearance

- Brainline Signage (funded by the centre).
- Colours of decoration within the Brainline Logo.

Essential hardware, software and facilities

- At least one computers and/or laptops for every three (3) learners, with full Microsoft software and internet access, supplied and maintained by the owner.

Service offered

- Advice and assistance on the operation of the Brainline Study material and cd.
- Access to the brainONLINE website for download and/or upload of tasks/tests/memos.
- Assistance with the download and upload of the same.
- Assistance with research via the internet for tasks and assignments.
- Contact point for Brainline learners for social events, as and when planned by the owners and/or learners and parents.
- Subject assistance by suitably qualified teachers (with SACE registration)

- The full Brainline Learning system is purchased by the owner/centre and is available to all learners.
- Teachers and Owner is trained in invigilation and each has their own invigilators codes.
- Academy may act as an examination centre, should facilities permit—an application for an examination centre has to be submitted and approved.
- Academy may offer classes to full time learners, up to a maximum of **20 learners**.
- Primary and High School learners must be adequately separated.

Who needs to be employed at the Brainline Learning Academy?

- The owner of the centre.
- An IT skilled person should be available on a freelance basis.
- Suitably skilled and accredited teachers should be available on contractual basis, or may be permanently employed.

What does the fees are payable by the members of the Academy?

- Clients pay the fee as determined by the centre.
- Fees should be related to the quality and number of services offered.

What fees are payable by the Academy, to Brainline?

- An administration fee of R5 000.00 once off, or R7 200.00 by debit order, **per year**.
- **Learners are enrolled as individuals with Brainline, according to the normal Brainline fees.**

What does Brainline offer the Academy?

- Free but compulsory training in the Brainline CD, www.brainonline.com, Study Methods, Management of the Centre
- Commission on enrolment of learners
- A service level contract.
- Frequent supportive visits from Brainline, with a minimum of once per term, but more should it be indicated.
