

## Brainline Accesspoint

### Who may have and operate a Brainline access point?

- Registered Brainline Clients/Families.
- The locality of the site is determined by the availability of 3G internet access via the MWEB uncapped ADSL system.
- Brainline controlled sites.

### Legalities

- A contract for the maintenance and security of the hardware may be signed.
- A contract for the hours of accessibility to clients may be signed.

### Where are the Brainline access points?

- Participating Brainline families (in remote areas).

### Appearance

- Brainline Signage (sponsored by Brainline)

### Essential hardware and software.

- A single laptop, without any Microsoft Software—only singular access to the website: [www.brainonline.com](http://www.brainonline.com), is supplied by Brainline.

### Service offered

- Only access to the brainONLINE website for download and/or upload of tasks/tests/memos.
- The person/s in charge of the access point may/may not be able to give assistance with uploads and/or downloads.

### Who needs to be employed at the Brainline Access point?

- There are no employees.

### What fees are payable by the user of the access point?

- Prospective clients pay no fees where the hardware and software are supported by Brainline.
- The person/s or family in charge of the access point, **may qualify for a discount in Brainline fees**, in relation to the number of learners making use of the access point.
- The number of learners making use of the access point may be limited by the person/family in charge of the point.

### What fees are payable to Brainline?

- None
- Learners making use of the facility are enrolled by the parent/guardian, directly with Brainline.

### Accessibility

- Access to the point will be determined by the person/family in charge, at the particular site.
